Code of Ethical Conduct

The maintenance of high standards of ethical conduct is a central responsibility shared by all members of Ezzree Institute (EI) and its Alumni Association and Membership Body. All alumni must agree to adhere to the standard of conduct established by EI and delineated below.

IN RELATION TO THOSE SERVED – as a member of the EI Alumni Association and Membership Body:

- I affirm and respect the human dignity and individual worth of each person.
- I do not discriminate against anyone in the following categories, including but not limited to race, ethnicity, gender, age, belief/spiritual orienting system, national origin, sexual orientation, socioeconomic status, housing status, or disability.
- I respect the integrity and welfare of others, refraining from disparagement and avoiding emotional, sexual, or any other kind of exploitation.
- I approach the convictions of others with respect and sensitivity.
 - o I refrain from the imposition of my theology, philosophical views, or cultural values on others.
 - o I respect the laws, regulations, and other applicable rules regarding confidentiality
- I follow professionally established guidelines in all engagements involving human subjects and gain approval from the relevant institutional body as required.
- I maintain and respect appropriate boundaries as befitting a spiritual care provider and/or spiritual leader. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - o I will not accept inappropriate gifts

I will rely on feedback from and consultation with peers and colleagues as a regular part of my practice. As appropriate for my personal and professional development and area(s) of expertise, I will engage in continuing education that can be demonstrated, if asked, for a minimum of 50 hours per year. These categories can be accomplished independently and/or through conferences, classes, psychotherapy, and any means through which personal development is augmented. I will engage in a periodic, structured peer review as determined by the Alumni Association. As part of my peer review, I will demonstrate a commitment to my own wellbeing in order to best maintain healthy interactions in my professional responsibilities.
